

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF OURAY COUNTY,  
COLORADO REGARDING THE VACINATION OF DOGS, CATS AND FERRETS IN  
UNINCORPORATED OURAY COUNTY, COLORADO**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners is authorized pursuant to C.R.S. 30-15-101, *et seq.* to adopt a regulation for the vaccination, control and licensing, including rabies vaccinations, of dogs and other pet animals; and

**WHEREAS**, the Colorado General Assembly amended C.R.S. 30-15-101 during the 2014 Session to specifically include authorization to control and require licensing and rabies vaccinations for cats and ferrets as well as dogs and other pets; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners has previously adopted a comprehensive resolution regarding the vaccination, control and impoundment of dogs, Resolution No. 2008-058, attached hereto for easy reference;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
COMMISSIONERS OF OURAY COUNTY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Dog owners are reminded of the provisions of Resolution No. 2008-058, and the requirement for regular rabies vaccinations to protect their dogs and the public.
2. Cat and ferret owners should also ensure that their pets have been inoculated by a licensed veterinarian against rabies according to the guidelines as recommended by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment and the Compendium of Animal Rabies Prevention and Control prepared by the National Association of State Public Health Veterinarians.
