**RESOLUTION
OURAY COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
2013 Lease Purchase for Ouray County Sheriff Vehicle**

Whereas, Ouray County ("County") is a political subdivision of the State of Colorado and a duly organized and existing County Government pursuant to Title 30, Colorado Revised Statutes; and

Whereas, pursuant to applicable law, the County is authorized to acquire, dispose of and encumber real and personal property, including without limitation rights and interest in property and leases necessary to the functions and operation of the County; and

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") of Ouray County hereby finds and determines that the execution of a lease-purchase agreement to purchase one (1) 2013, Chevrolet Tahoe 4WD Truck for the Ouray County Sheriff's Department in the principal and interest amount of \$27,386.52 is appropriate and necessary to the function and operation of the County; and

Whereas, The Citizens State Bank of Ouray shall act as Lessor under said lease.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Board of Ouray County Commissioners as follows:

1. **Authority to Enter into Lease Purchase Financing.** The Board Chair is authorized to execute such contracts and supporting documents with The Citizens State Bank of Ouray, in substantially the form set forth in the document presently before the County Board, for the lease-purchase financing of one (1) 2013 Chevrolet Tahoe 4WD Truck for the Ouray County Sheriff's Department. All other related contracts and agreements necessary and incidental to the Lease are hereby authorized.
2. **Lease Subject to Annual Appropriation.** The County's obligations under the Lease shall be subject to annual appropriation or renewal by the County Board as set forth in each Lease and the County's obligations under the Lease shall not constitute general obligations of the County or indebtedness under the Constitution or laws of the State.
3. **Qualified Tax-Exemption.** The County is a qualified, tax exempt, governmental agency pursuant to the Department of the Treasury, Internal Revenue Service, and the State of Colorado, and said Lease is a qualified tax-exempt obligation.
4. **Severability.** If any part, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions.
5. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced immediately upon its approval by the Board of Ouray County Commissioners.






