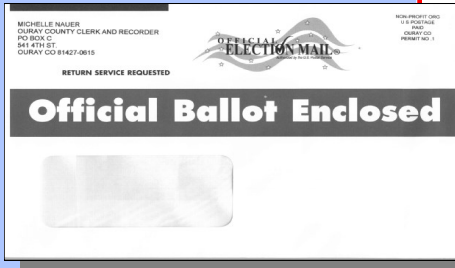


Ouray County Clerk & Recorder

2017 COORDINATED ELECTION ***Tuesday, November 7, 2017***

VOTER REGISTRATION:

- **DO** verify the Clerk's Office has your current mailing address on file for you.
(www.govotecolorado.com)
- **DO** put your voted ballot back in the secrecy sleeve before placing it in the return envelope.
- **DO** sign the return envelope under the flap, where indicated.
- **DO** sign with your normal signature.
- **DO** put a first-class stamp on the envelope before mailing.
- **DO** stop by the Clerk's office to get a replacement ballot if you spoil your ballot.

Election Day - Tuesday, November 7,
2017 - 7:00 am to 7:00 pm

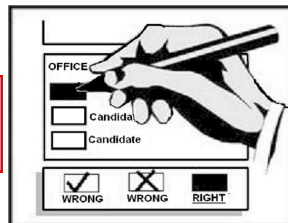

WHEN VOTING YOUR BALLOT:

- **DON'T** use checkmarks
- **DON'T** smudge
- **DON'T** use various color inks
- **DON'T** use red ink
- **DON'T** use felt-tip pens
- **DON'T** spill food or beverages on your ballot
- **DON'T** use white-out to correct a mistake

Frequently Asked Questions

WHY DO I HAVE TO SIGN MY OFFICIAL RETURN ENVELOPE?

Voters' signatures on their ballot envelope must be verified against the **signature on file for that voter to ensure the elector voted their own ballot, and to protect the integrity of the election.**

A voter whose signature is challenged or missing will receive a letter with an affidavit and instructions to "cure" the issue. The affidavit must be returned by the 8th day after the election in order for their eligible ballot to be counted.

WHAT IF I FORGET TO SIGN MY RETURN ENVELOPE?

A voter whose signature is missing will receive a letter with an affidavit and instructions to "cure" the issue. The affidavit must be returned by the 8th day after the election in order for their eligible ballot to be counted.

DO I HAVE TO RETURN MY BALLOT BY MAIL?

No, you may return your ballot by mail or deliver it to a Drop Off Location or Voter Services Polling Center no later than 7pm on election day.

Postmarks do not count as received.

WHAT IS THE DEADLINE TO RETURN MY BALLOT?

No later than 7:00 pm on Election Day!

Postmarks do not count as received.

WHAT IF I MAKE A MISTAKE ON MY BALLOT?

Do not attempt to correct it or use whiteout. You must contact the Ouray County Clerk's Office for instructions on how to obtain a replacement ballot.

WHAT IF I FORGET THE SECRECY SLEEVE?

Eligible ballots will be counted regardless of whether or not they are returned in a secrecy sleeve.

CAN SOMEONE FIND OUT HOW I VOTED?

No. The procedure for processing mail ballots ensures that secrecy is maintained for each voter's ballot.
