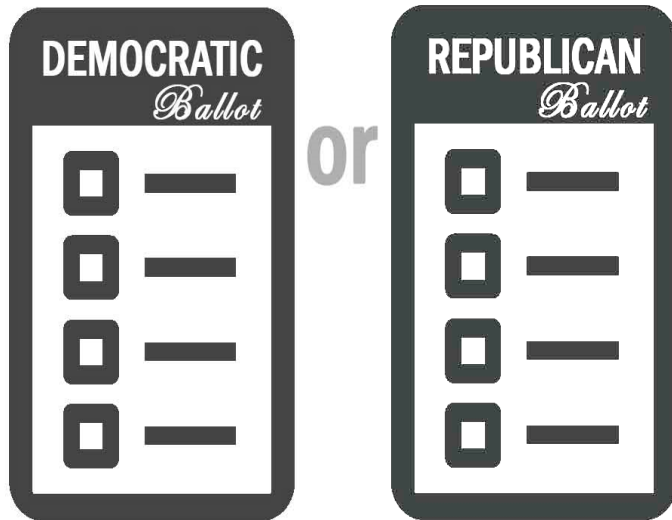


Unaffiliated Voters **Make your vote count.**

RETURN *Only One* **BALLOT**



VOTE ONLY ONE

Recent changes in Colorado law now allow unaffiliated voters to vote in a primary election.

Here's how it works:

1. You received two ballots in your packet: one from the Democratic Party and one from the Republican Party.
2. Choose **ONLY ONE** of these ballots and fill it out. *Your vote in this election will not affiliate you with a political party. Please tear up and throw away the ballot you won't use.*
3. Return **ONLY ONE** voted ballot in the return envelope. *Returning two voted ballots will disqualify all of your votes.*
4. Sign the Affidavit of Voter on your ballot return envelope and return your ballot before 7:00 P.M. on Election Day.
