COVID-19 Cases (+/- is the difference from this time Saturday): (From CDC and CDPE's report that are updated 4pm daily this numbers have increased by the time of this report).

- The United States has 122,653 (+37,297) cases and 2,112 (+866) deaths impacting all 50 states as well as District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam, North Marianas (New) and US Virgin Islands.
- Colorado has 2307 (+573) cases, 326 (+87) Hospitalized, impacting 46 (+4) counties, 47 (+16) deaths, 14,470 (+2,794) tested, and 10 (+1) outbreaks
- West Region Counties Cases: Delta has 1 (-1) case, Gunnison has 79 (+13) cases and 1 death (+/- 0), Montrose has 8 (+2) case, San Miguel has 1 (+/-0) case, and Hinsdale has 1 (+/-0) case.
- Ouray County has Zero (0) reported cases.

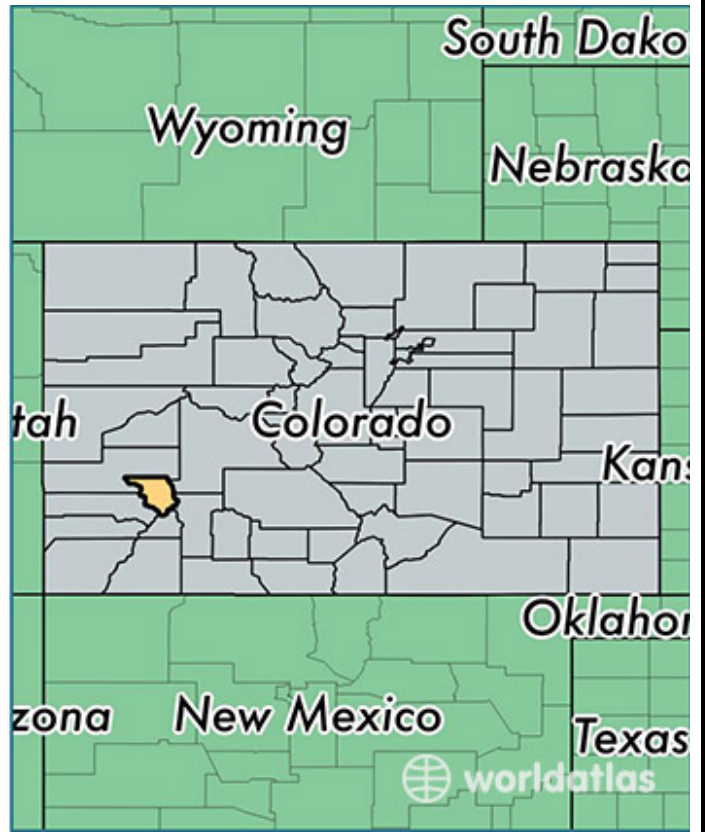
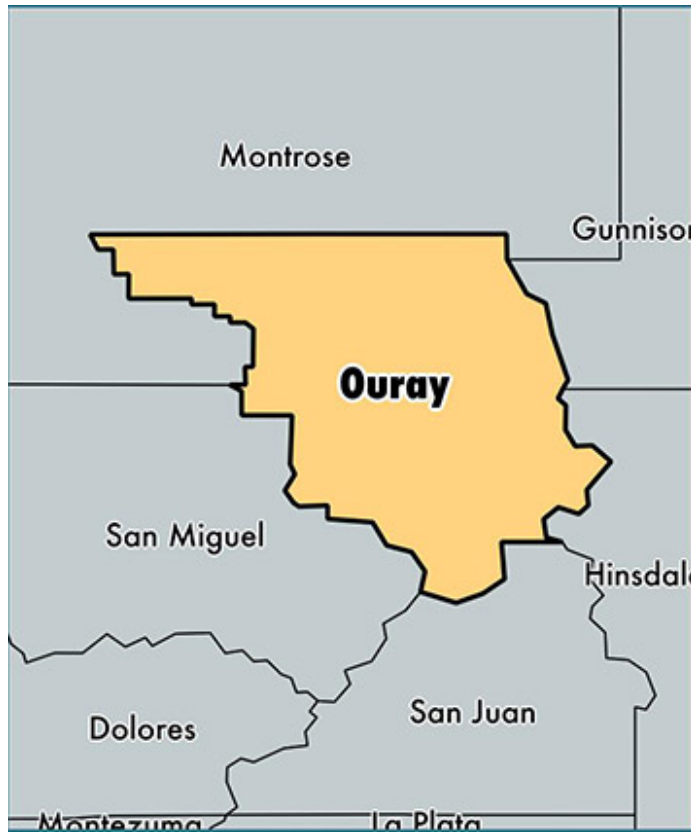

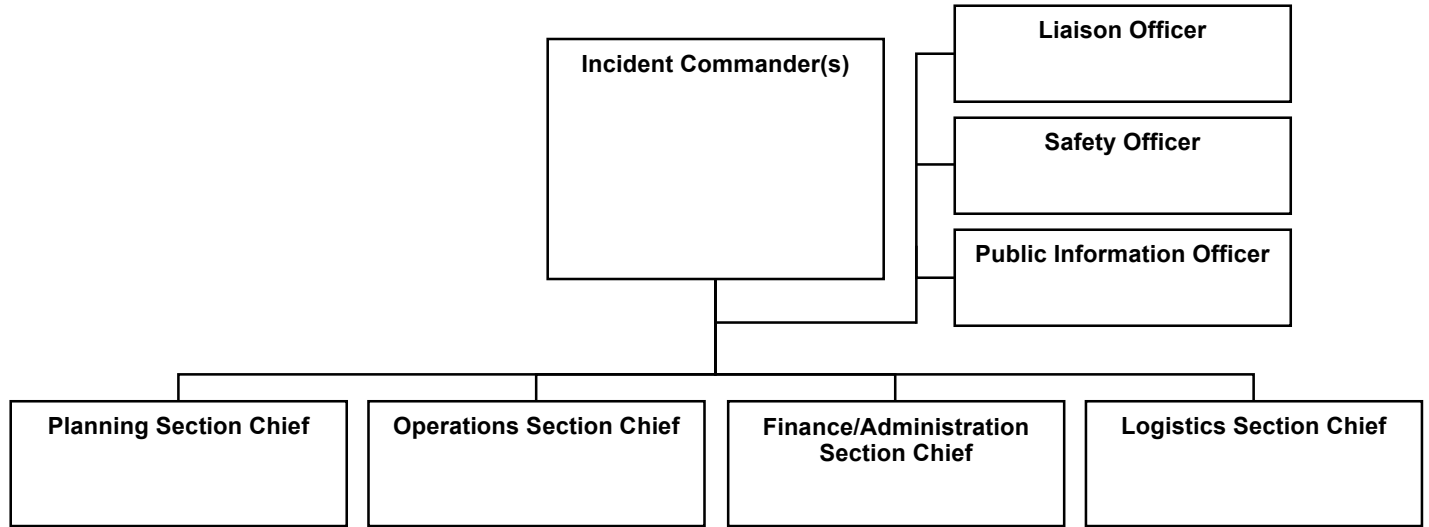
