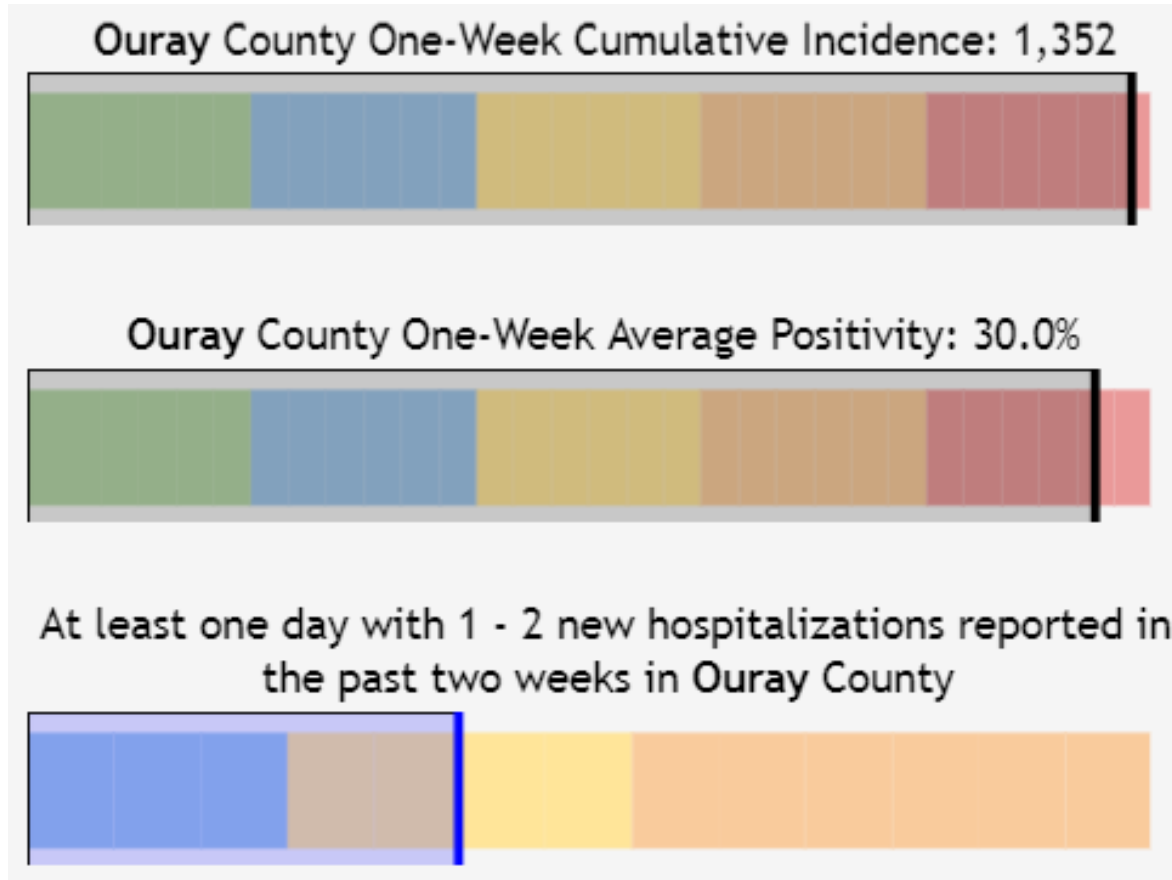

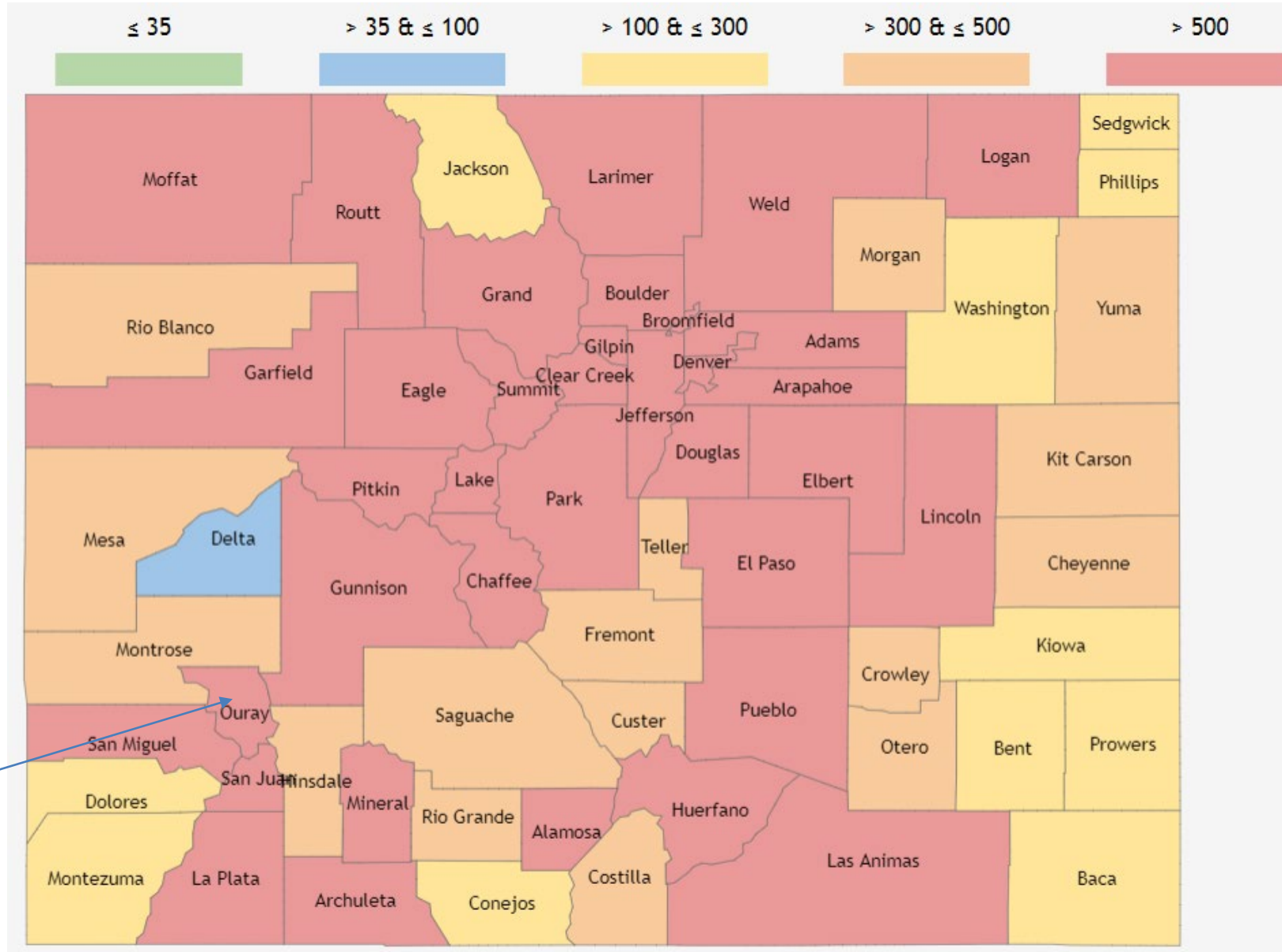

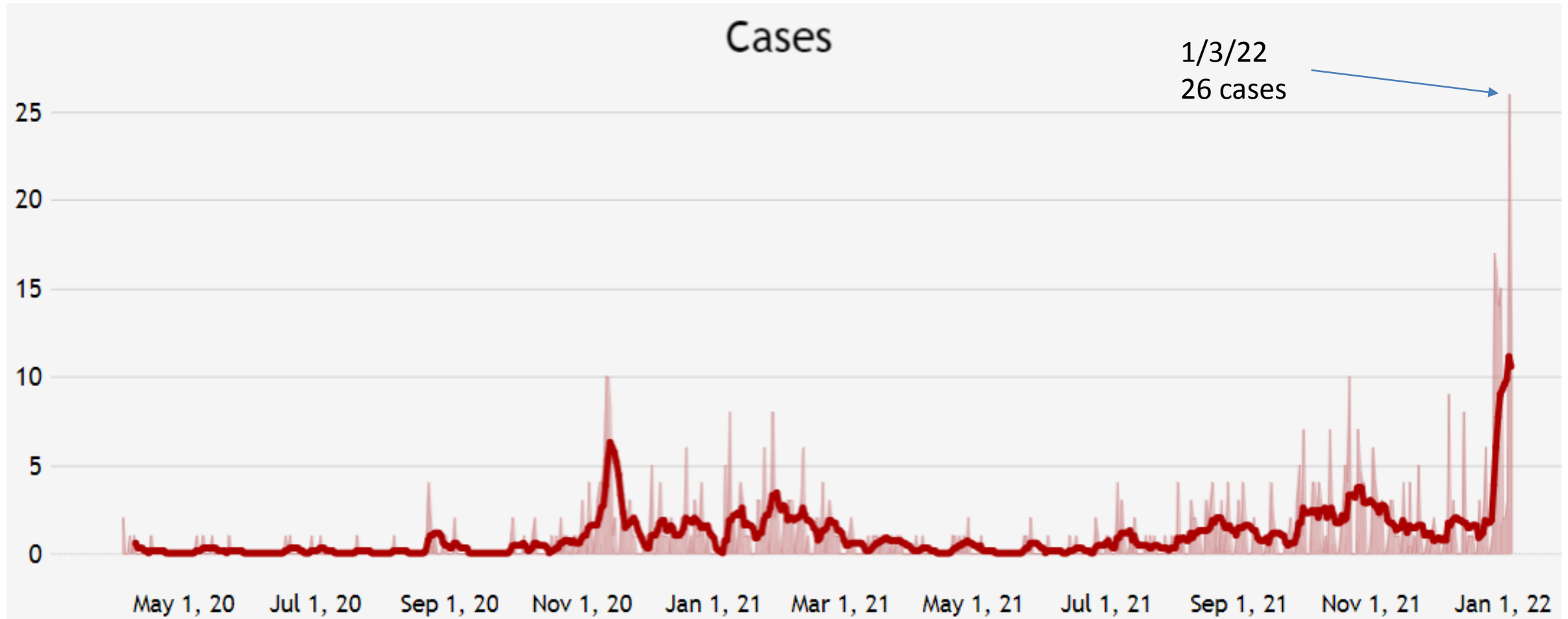


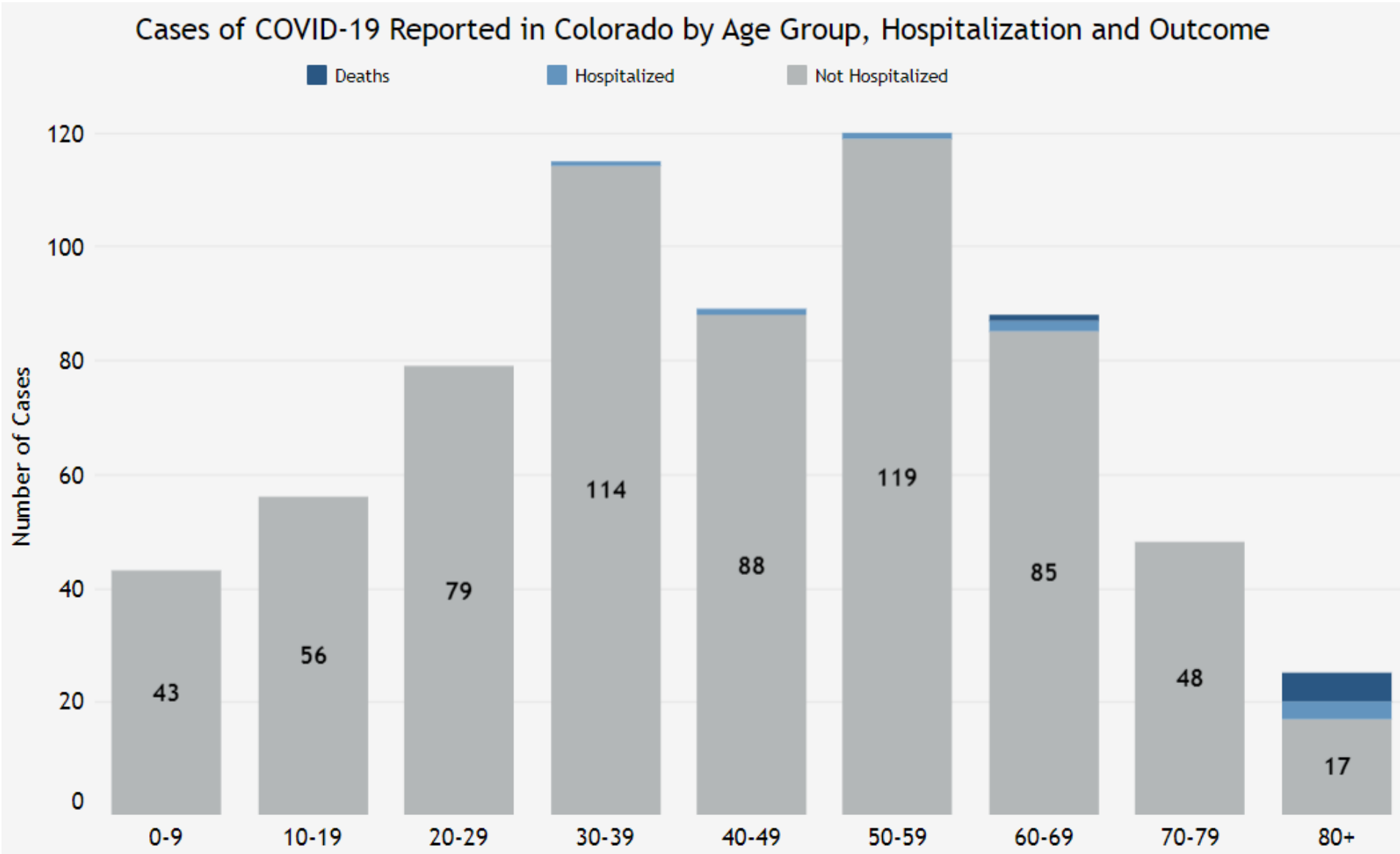

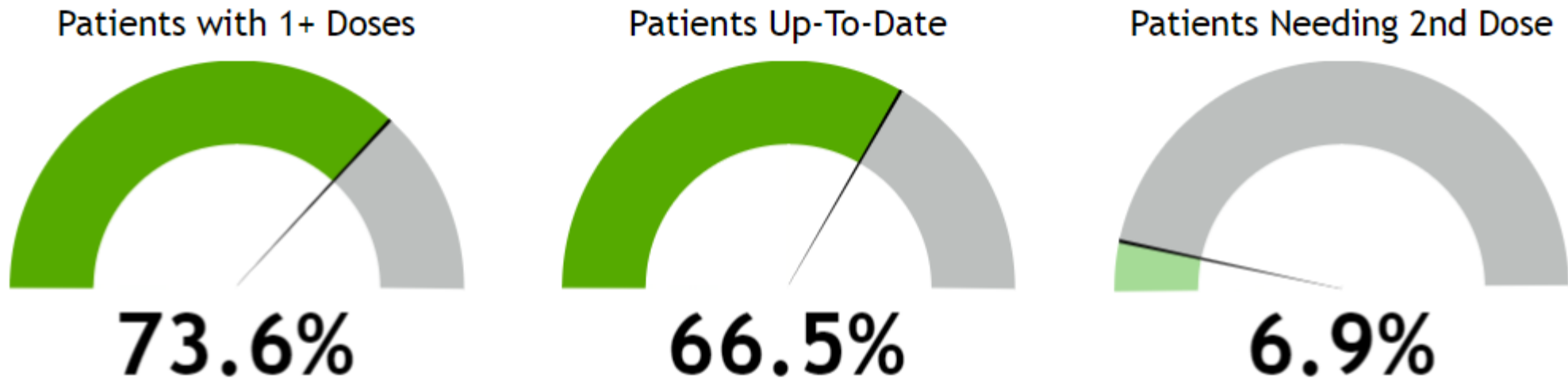

Every County has a goal of having 75% of their eligible population immunized by 7/4/2021



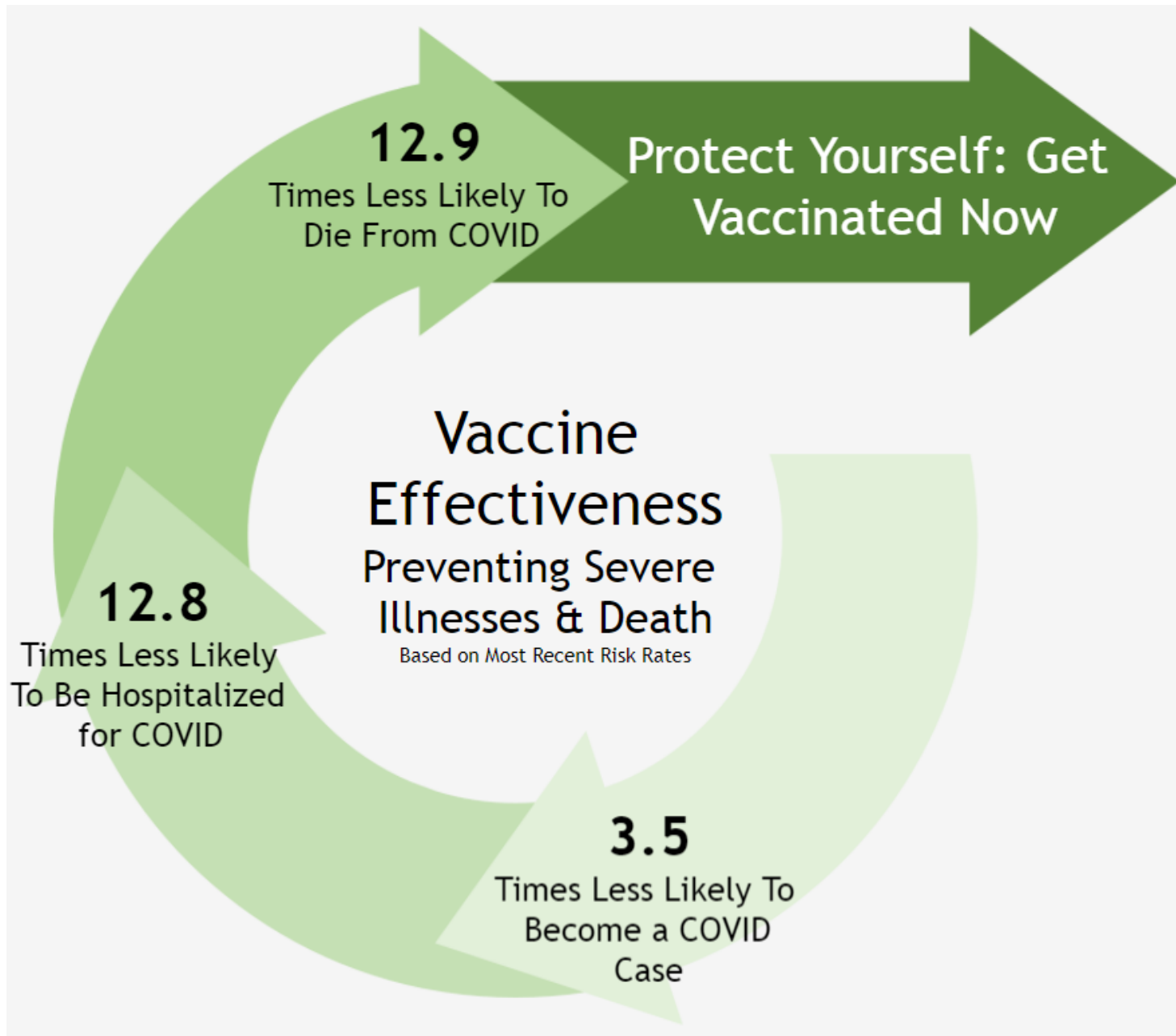

Vaccinated people are **12.8** times less likely to be hospitalized & **12.9** times less likely to die due to COVID19

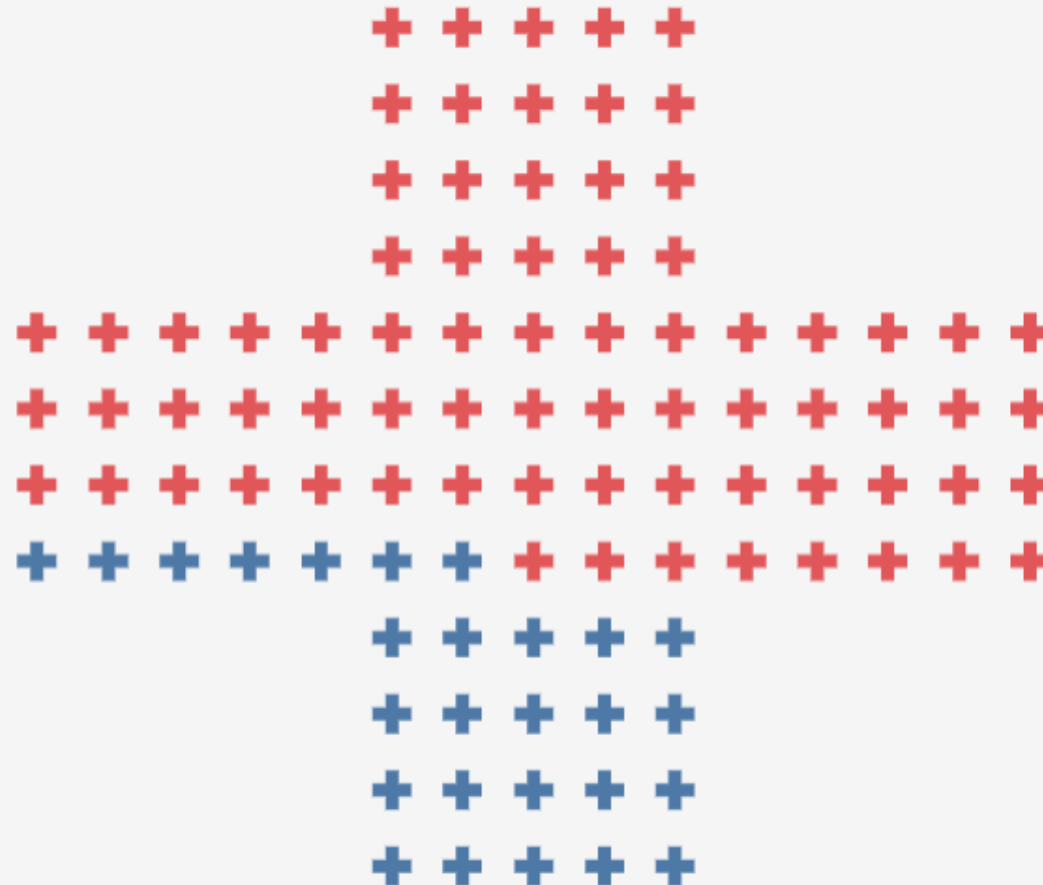


73% of Those Currently Hospitalized are Unvaccinated

The vaccination status of those currently hospitalized is based on data reported daily to public health by hospitals through the Healthcare Emergency Resource Management system (EMResource). Vaccination status of currently hospitalized individuals is reported in aggregate, and therefore not verified by public health at the patient level. EMResource data provides a snapshot of hospitalizations in Colorado, and is meant to be used for situational awareness. 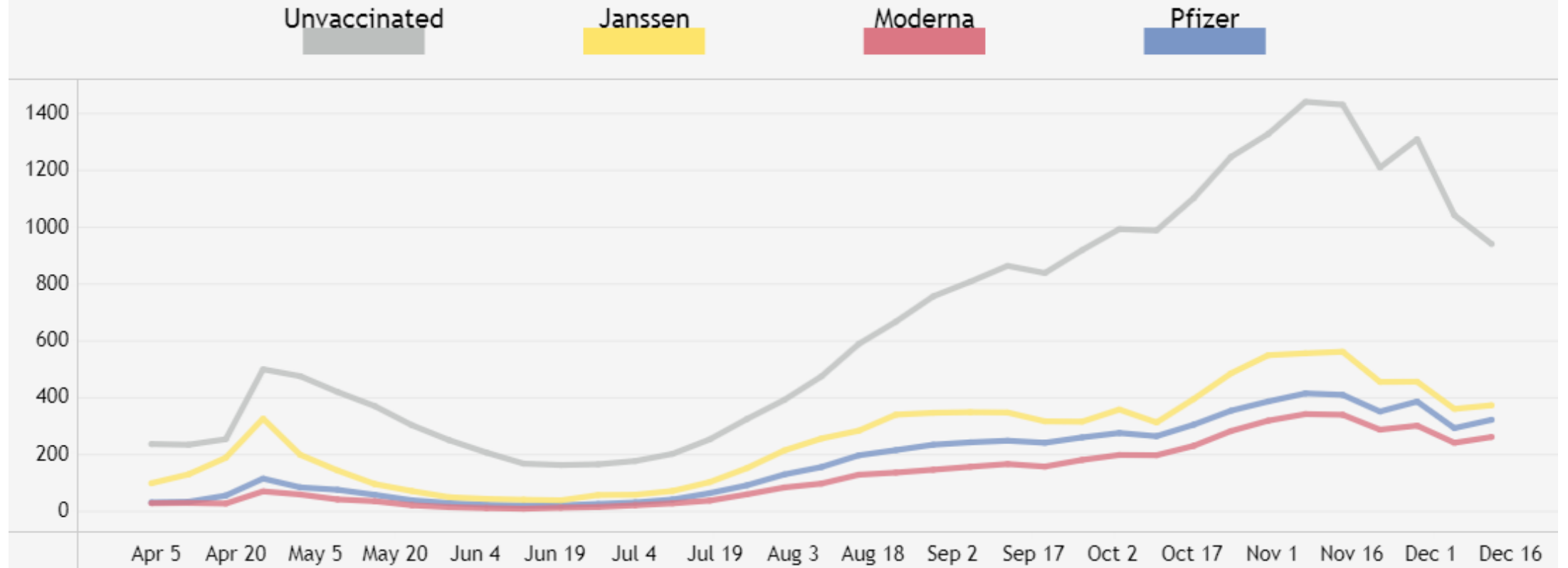
