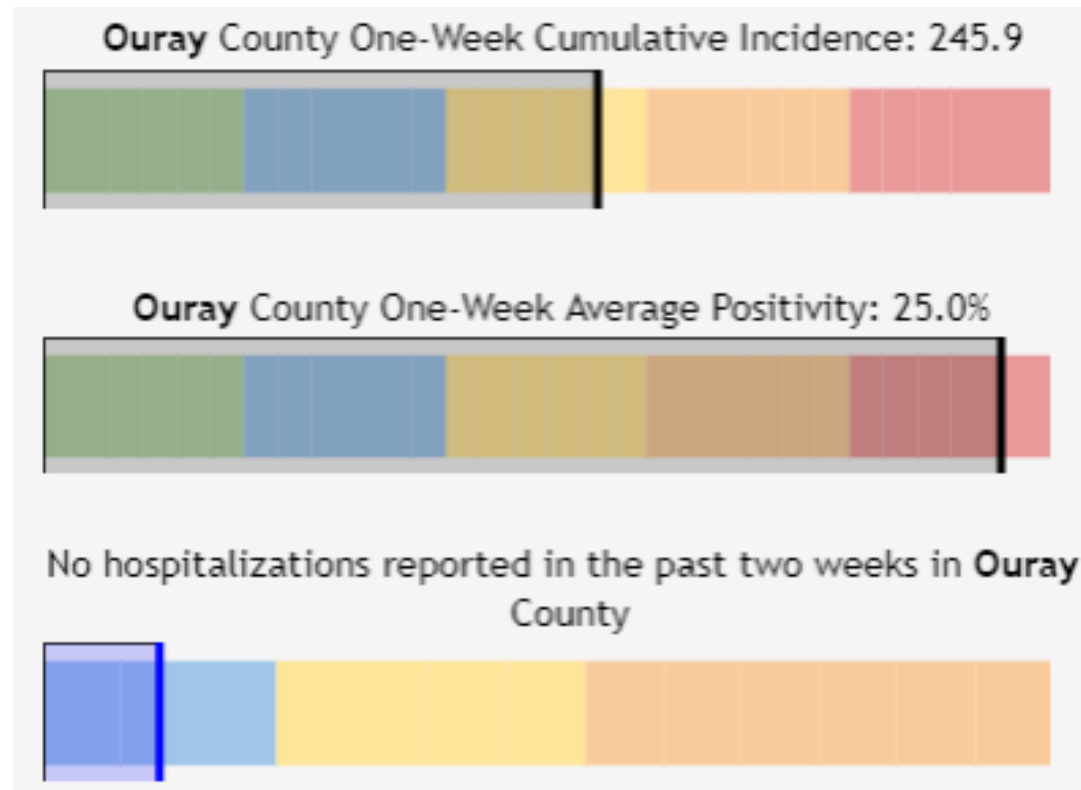


# Statewide Key Updates

- Cases and percent positivity are slowly trending down in Colorado. Overall, U.S. cases are flat and hospitalization trends have been slowly increasing.
- The 7-day moving average number of cases is ~1,550, down from a peak of ~2,400 on June 9th (low of 303 in March).
- Hospitalizations in Colorado are relatively flat.
- CDC Nowcast modeling demonstrates an increase in proportion of BA.5 and a decrease in BA.4 and BA.2.12.1; BA.5 now represents ~82% of cases nationally, and 85% and in region 8.

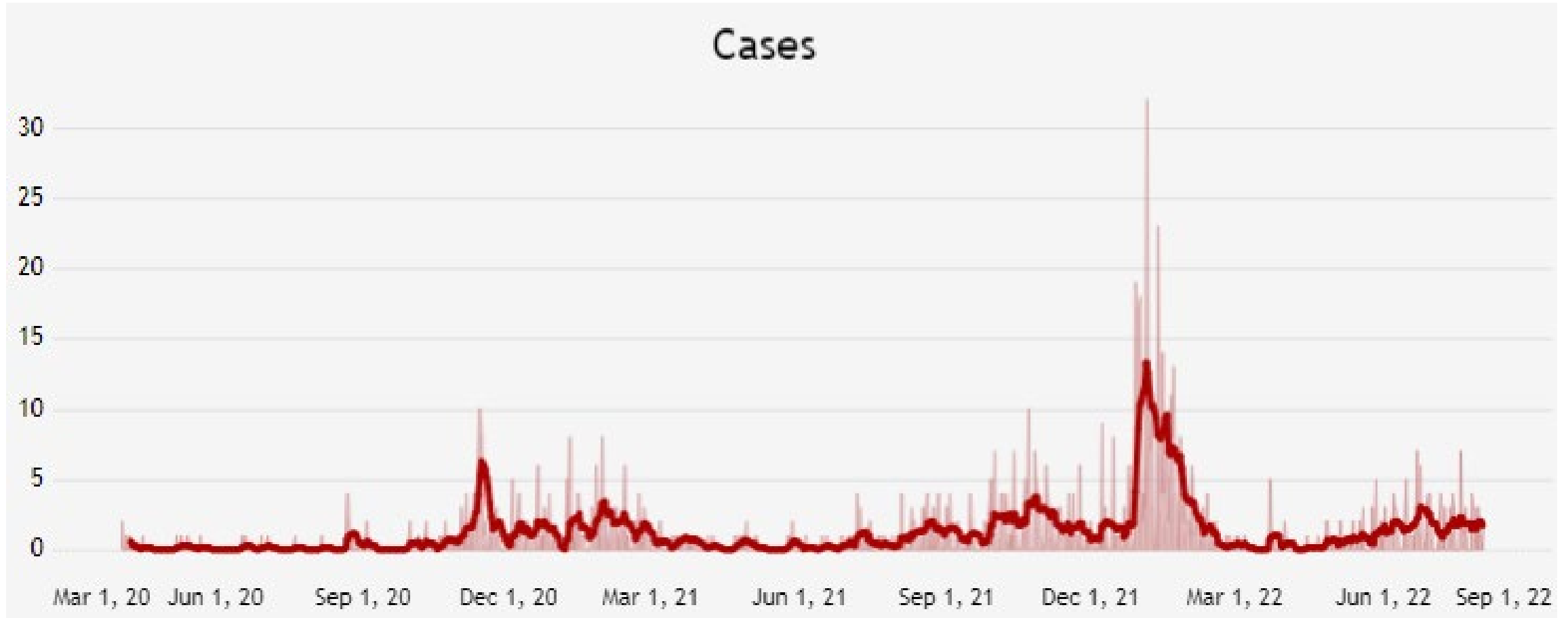

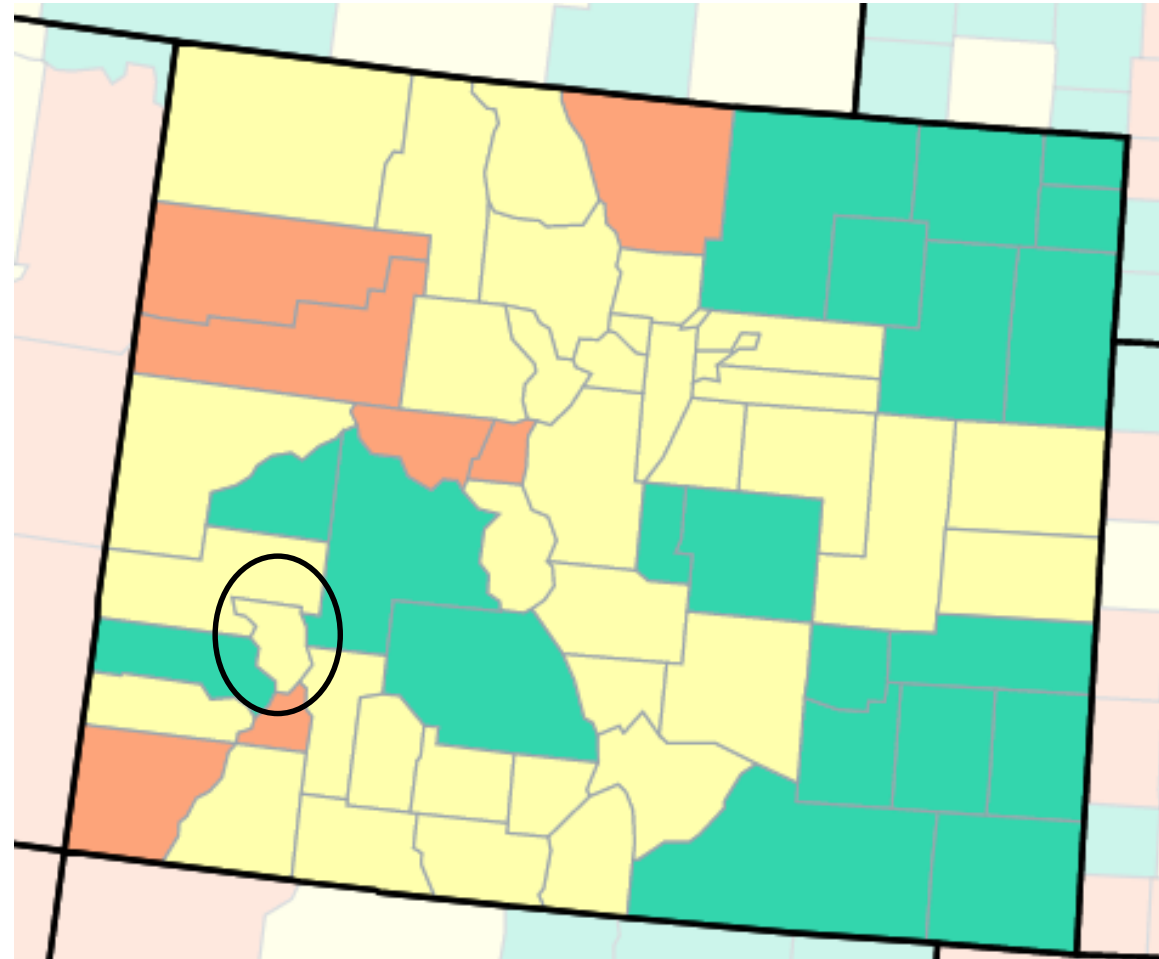

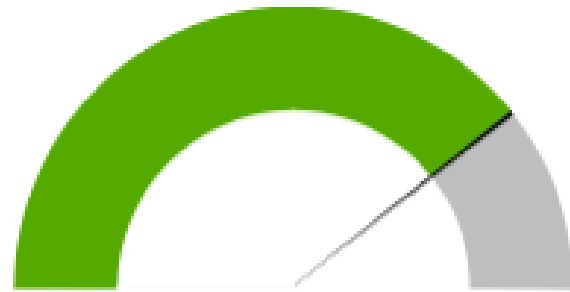

# Ouray County COVID-19 Vaccination Status

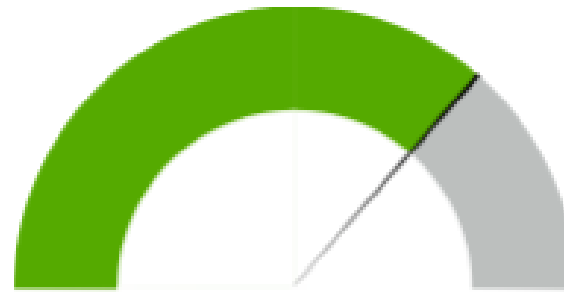
Every County has a goal of having 75% of their eligible population immunized by 7/4/2021

Patients with 1+ Doses



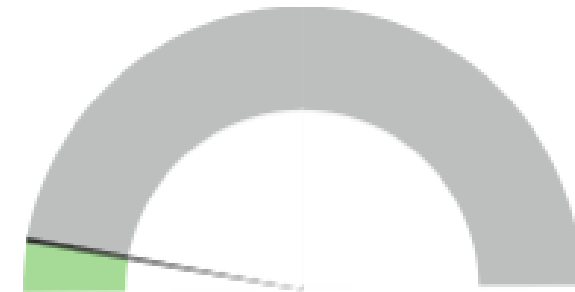

# COVID-19 treatments are available statewide.

**Coloradans who test positive or think they have COVID-19 should ask a healthcare provider about treatment.**

- Treatment works best if it's taken within a few days of getting sick. Seek treatment fast to lower the risk of serious illness.
- Some providers offer testing and treatment in an all-in-one experience called Test to Treat.
- Coloradans who are moderately to severely immunocompromised, or who can't get vaccinated against COVID-19, can take preventive medicine called Evusheld.
