

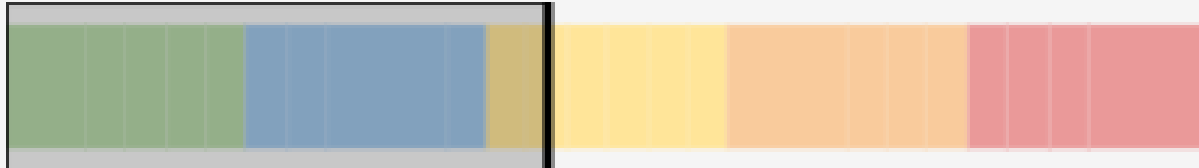

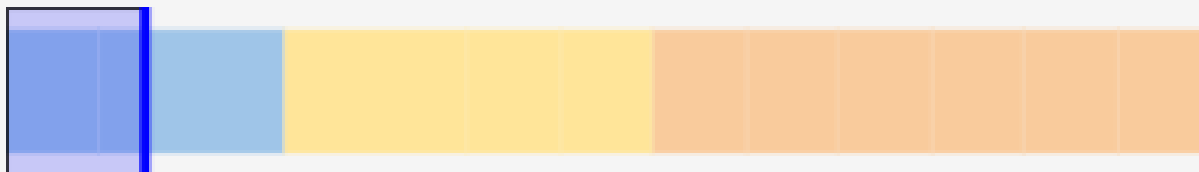
Ouray County One-Week Cumulative Incidence: 102.4



Ouray County One-Week Average Positivity: 21.4%

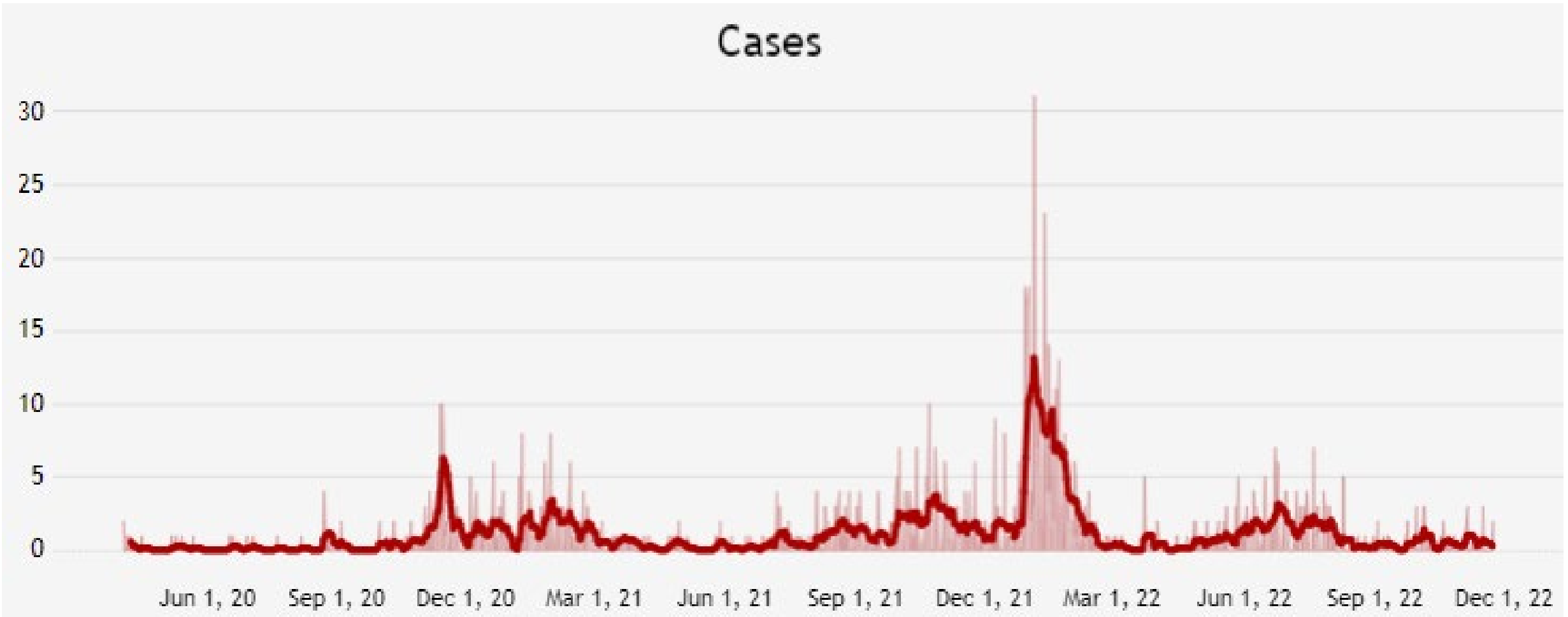

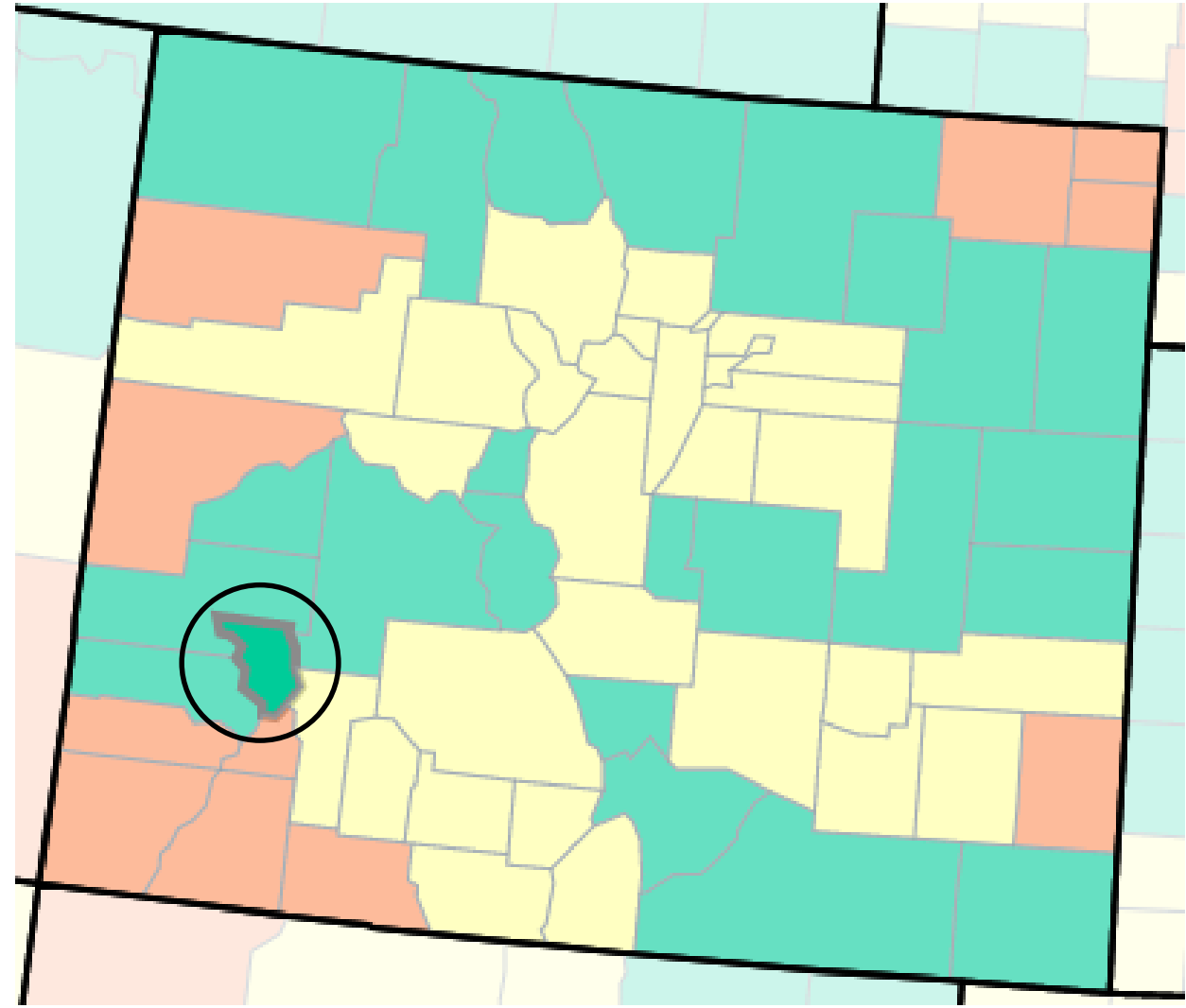

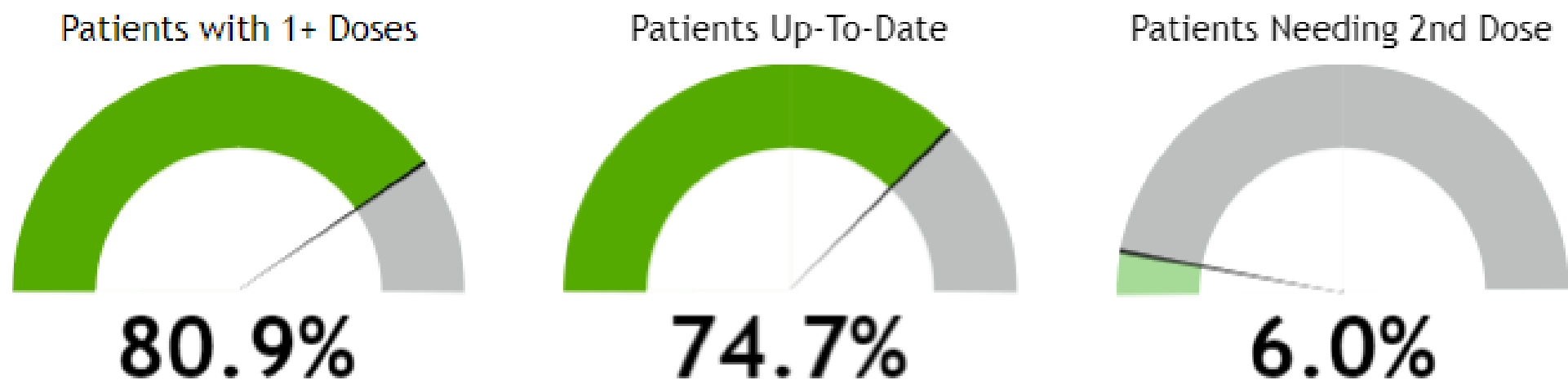
What Prevention Steps Should You Take Based on Your COVID-19 Community Level?

Every County has a goal of having 75% of their eligible population immunized by 7/4/2021

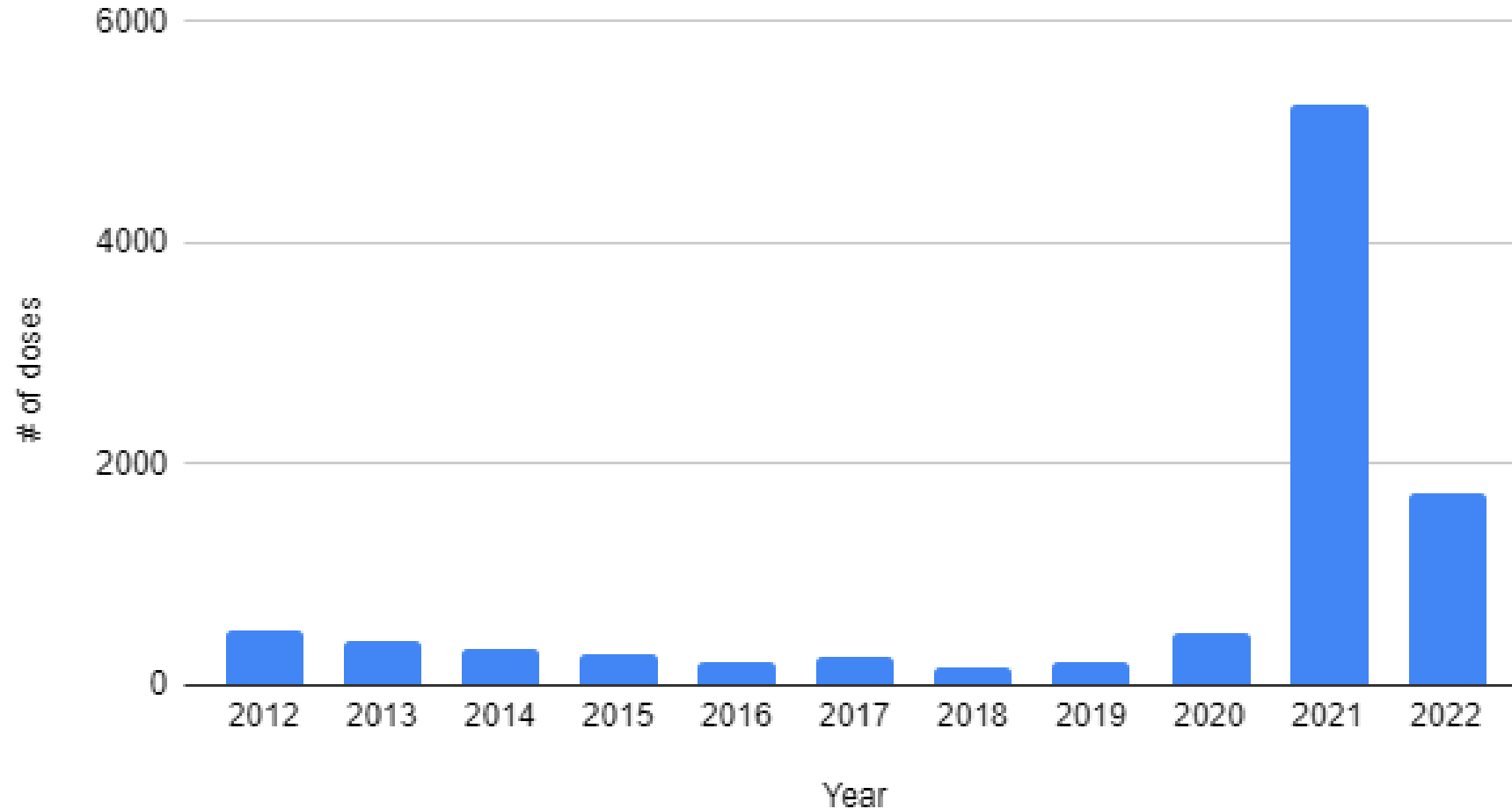

COVID-19 treatments are available statewide.

Coloradans who test positive or think they have COVID-19 should ask a healthcare provider about treatment.

- Treatment works best if it's taken within a few days of getting sick. Seek treatment fast to lower the risk of serious illness.
- Some providers offer testing and treatment in an all-in-one experience called Test to Treat.
- Coloradans who are moderately to severely immunocompromised, or who can't get vaccinated against COVID-19, can take preventive medicine called Evusheld.
