## Key COVID-19 Updates

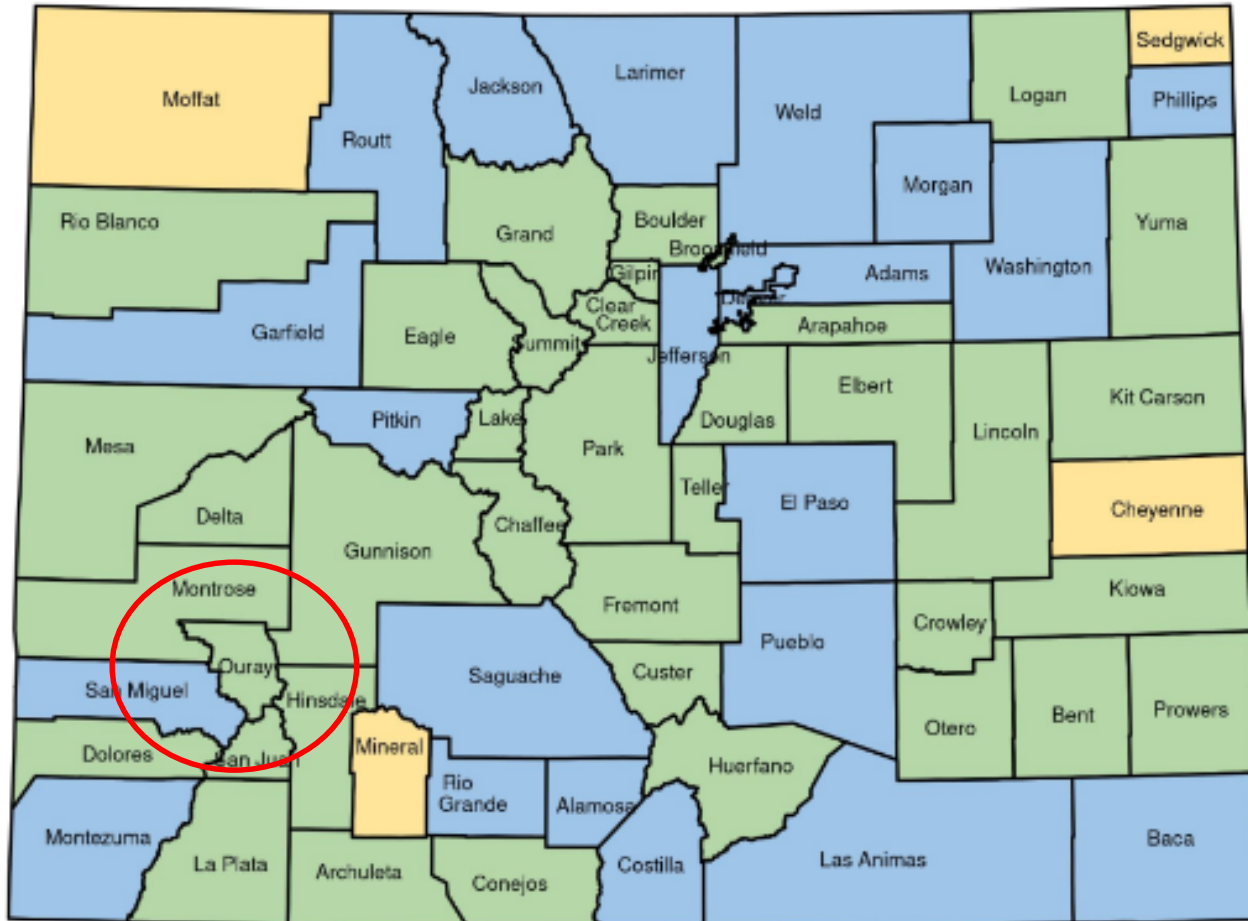
- Cases and percent positivity declined last week
- The 7-day moving average number of cases is -310, down from -1,100 in early December
- Hospitalization data in Colorado are mixed:
  - HHS Protect shows no change in admissions
  - EMResource shows slight decline in number currently hospitalized
- Overall, U.S. cases and hospitalizations are decreasing, with considerable regional variability
- CDC Nowcast variant model for US continues to change:
  - XBB.1.5 remains the dominant subvariant and continues to increase (49.0%)
  - Region 8 currently has lower proportions of XBB.1.5 (19.0%) but XBB.1.5 is rising
- XBB.1.5 continues to receive media attention. Key takeaways are that XBB.1.5 is likely **more transmissible** than previous variants/subvariants but has **similar immune escape** as recent subvariants and has **no greater severity**.

Outbreaks: **8**

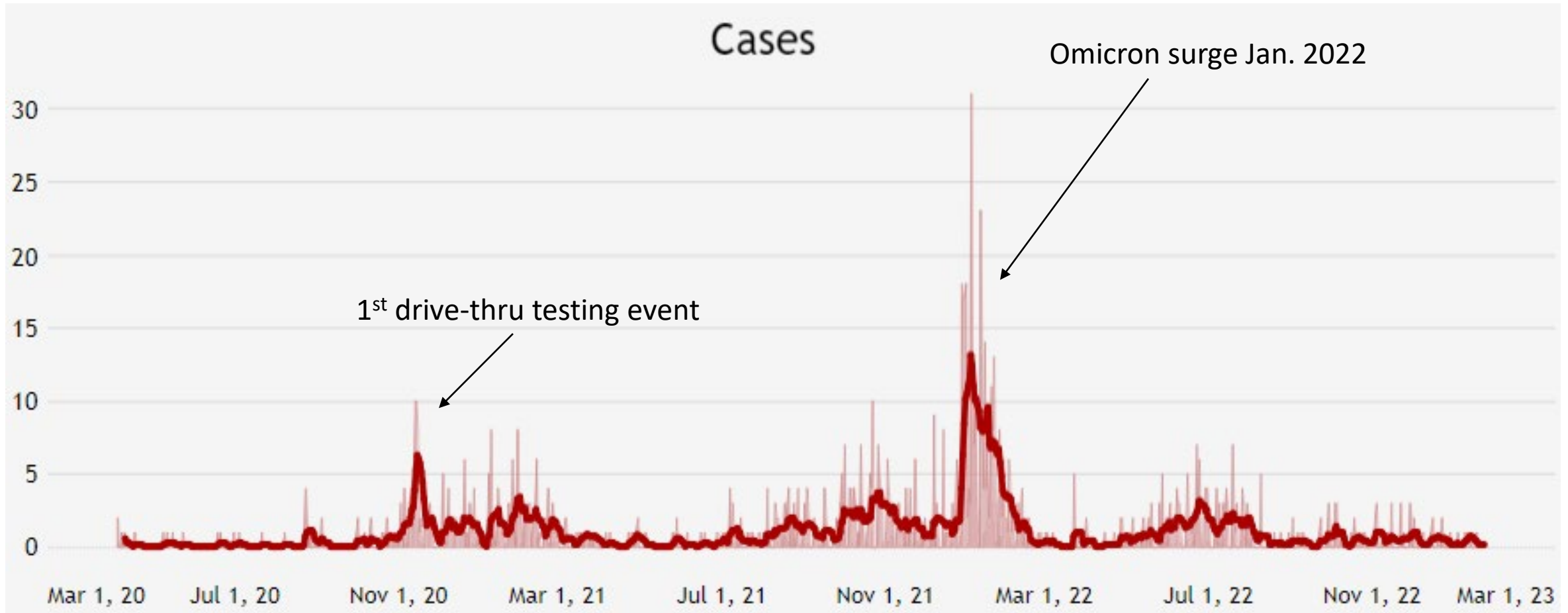
Active Cases (last 10 days): **1**

Cases last **30 days**: **8**

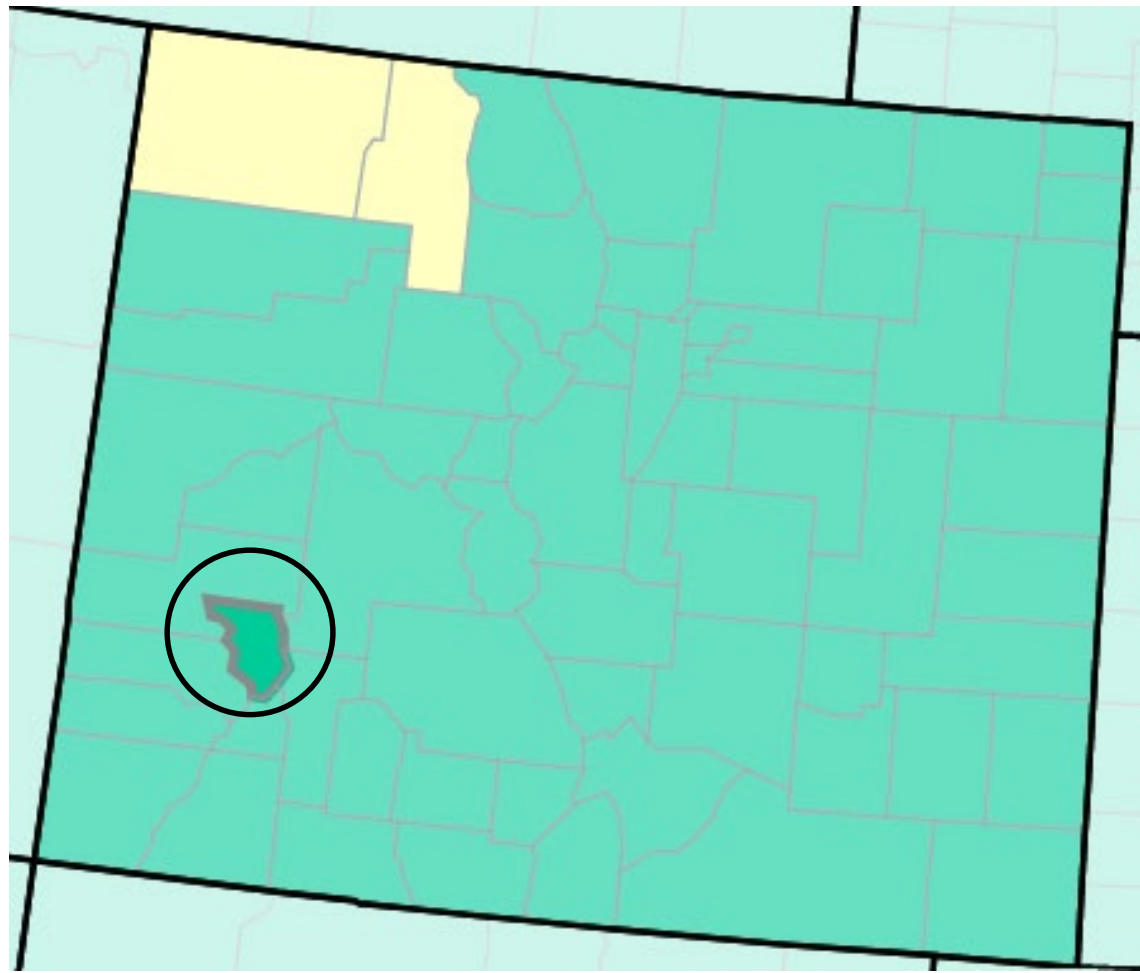

Patients with 1+ Doses



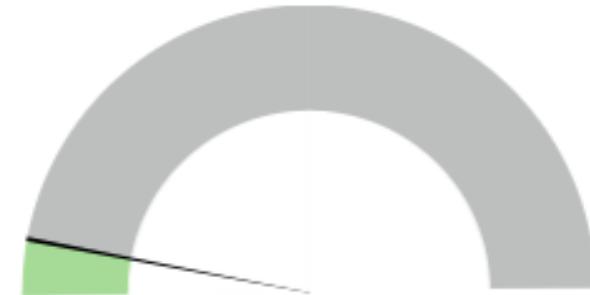

# How can I help prevent transmission of respiratory illnesses?

- **Get vaccinated.** Both flu and COVID-19 have effective, safe vaccines. Anyone 6 months and older can get vaccinated for flu and COVID-19. It is safe to get the vaccines together.
- **Stay home** when you are sick with respiratory symptoms, including not visiting or interacting with people who may be immunocompromised or at higher risk, including older adults, young children, and infants.
- **Encourage frequent handwashing** and proper hand-hygiene techniques. Wash your hands regularly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
